<u>Consider/Act on Merton Fire Department Budget for 2023</u>. No representatives from Merton Community Fire Department in attendance. No action taken.

<u>Consider/Act on Assessor Contract with Assessment Technologies of Wisconsin LLC</u>. Nate Carlsen from Assessment Technologies also known as Grota Appraisal reviewed the contract for the board. He also talked about the Equalized Value determined by the State of Wisconsin and the impact that is having for the town. The Town will be non-complaint with its Assessed Value. The State requires assessed value to fair market value to be between 90% and 110%. The 2021 tax bill for the town was at 94.43%. Due to the WI Department of Revenue the increase of the Fair Market Value for 2022 the town will be dropping to around 83% and will have six years to bring that percentage into compliance.
